Quick Start Guide With Keypad

1. What's In The Box

- 1 spidertracks tracking unit – the 'spider' with bracket
- 1 power lead with cigarette lighter plug
- 1 keypad with bracket
- 1 USB reprogramming lead (depending on promotion)
- Promotional material

2. Sign Up To The Website.

If you haven't already done so, go to <http://app.spidertracks.com> and click the sign up button. This will take you through a few steps on setting up an account to the spidertracks website.

3. Add Vehicles

From the 'Account' heading at the top of the page go to 'Organisation Settings'. In the middle of this page you will see 'Register New Vehicle'. Click here and add new vehicles to the site. You can add as many vehicles as you need.

4. Add Users

On the 'Organisation Settings' page click 'Invite New User'. You can invite users with email addresses, so they will be able to login with their own credentials and view the tracks. Otherwise you can invite users without an email address, you will still be able to assign the spider to the user. You can add as many users as you need.

5. Register Spider

Go to 'Spiders' and click 'Register'. On the bottom of the spider beneath the bracket, is the serial number, this is also the registration code. Enter this into the system and click register.

Please note that there are no Zero's or One's. You will now be taken through the setup wizard.

6. Set Up Your Spider

In the list of spiders under 'Spiders' click on the 'setup' link. Here you can change the name of the spider, vehicle assigned, user assigned, and time/distance update – how many times the unit will send a position point. Remember to click update!

7. Set Up Your Keypad

Go to 'Spiders' and click on 'Keypads'. Click on edit to change the monitoring time interval, the radius distance, and to add descriptions into the mark button presses. Click the save button to update your keypad settings.

8. Adding Contacts

Go to 'alerts' and click 'contacts'. Here you can add people that will be contacted by email and SMS text message via cell phone when an alert is sent from your spiders. Remember to use international phone format.

9. Install Your Spider

Place your spider, using the adhesive backing on the bracket, in a position where it has a clear view of the sky. We recommend somewhere on the dashboard of the vehicle. It can be powered using the cigarette lighter plug. A red light on the spider top shows power, and amber shows it is tracking you!
